

Terms of Reference

- 1. The Mary Tavy Jubilee Group has been created by residents of the village of Mary Tavy to undertake or facilitate projects for the benefit of the community.
- 2. The aim of Mary Tavy Jubilee Group (MTJG) is to support and where possible improve the wellbeing and lived experiences of those in the Mary Tavy Parish.
- 3. The Mary Tavy Jubilee Group is committed to canvassing parishioners views, to identify needs then devise and carry out projects that achieve beneficial outcomes for residents of Mary Tavy Parish.
- 4. The MTJG will, by consent, facilitate other groups and organisations in Mary Tavy to help get tasks and projects underway.
- 5. MTJG has a history of success in fundraising and sourcing grants for a variety of projects but does not seek to supplant or replicate the work of other groups.
- 6. The Mary Tavy Jubilee Group will occasionally when resources allow make small one off grants to local organisations that will benefit the community and local residents.
- 7. The Mary Tavy Jubilee Group will remain open to suggestions from residents as to suitable projects that it might facilitate or undertake and thus benefit the community of Mary Tavy.
- 8. The Mary Tavy Jubilee Group will continue to gather information about local events, concerns and happenings that need wider dissemination and communication to local residents by publishing a newsletter (Jubilee News) that is independent of statutory or local political structures. Jubilee News will through its sponsored columns and advertising aims to be a self-funding.
- 9. MTJG will operate as a formally constituted local group with trustees and affiliates. It will operate within Charity Commission and NCVO guidelines for groups and voluntary organisations.
